一、實施目的：

1. 鼓勵學生學習英語，開拓學生視野，培養其國際觀並厚植英語實力。
2. 讓學生從競賽過程互相切磋、交換經驗，為相關英語競賽儲備人才。

二、主辦單位：本校教務處

三、參加對象：本校 3~6 年級學生(4~6 年級每班 3 位，3 年級鼓勵參加)

四、報名日期：即日起至 9 月底(有意願學生請向英語老師報名)

五、競賽時間：10 月 13 日(二)第五、六節於忠孝樓 3F 會議室。

六、競賽方式

1. 朗讀篇目於比賽前公佈於校網。
2. 每人限 3 分鐘或文章朗讀畢，立即下台。未下台者，每 30 秒扣平均總分 1 分（不足 30 秒，30 秒計）。
3. 參賽學生若需相關文具或字典者，應自備。
4. 評分規則：語音（發音及聲調）50%、氣勢（句讀、語調、文氣）30%、儀態（儀容、態度、表情）20%
5. 每組取前 5 名頒獎，前三名加贈便利商店商品卡 100 元。

七、未來對外英語競賽名額有限之時，以兩年校內相關英語競賽獲獎較優者優先報名參賽。
